I am writing to thank you for your generous donation of fabric to my charity. It will be used to make lap quilts for adult cancer patients receiving treatment at the Carol G. Simon Cancer Center in Overlook Hospital.

I started Jinny's Rainbow Comfort Quilts in the spring of 2010 as a way to thank the doctors, nurses, and staff for the compassionate and dignified way they treated my mother, Jinny, when she was undergoing chemotherapy for lung cancer. My mom was only in the hospital for a few hours a month, but I saw that there were many patients who were there for hours at a time with only the drab hospital blankets for warmth.

After my mother died, I researched places where I could put my love of sewing to use and help others as well. I found many places that made blankets, quilts, etc. for infants and children, but found none locally that catered to adults. That is why I started Jinny's Rainbow. The staff at Overlook is incredibly grateful, and unfortunately, the need far outweighs our ability to keep up.

We use a very basic pattern, but it has resulted in over 400 lap quilts donated to Overlook to date. I hold quilting days once a month in my home, both during the day and at night. My band of quilters includes sewers, ironers, sorters and kit makers. We put together kits that people can take home and make up at their leisure. Your generous donation ensures that we can continue.
